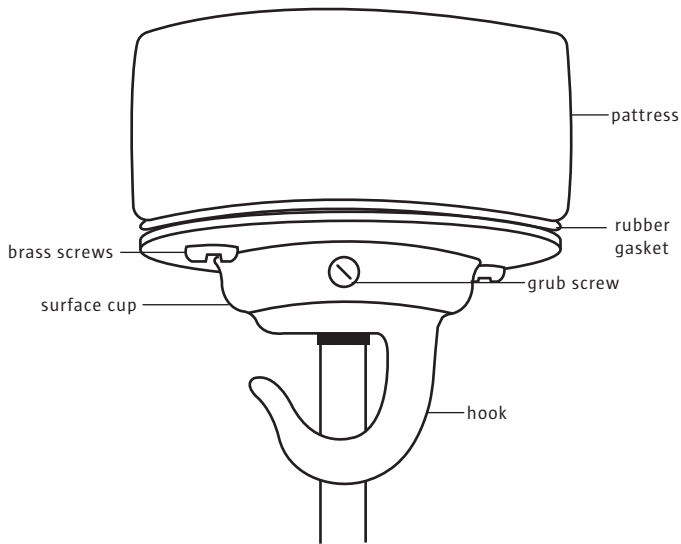
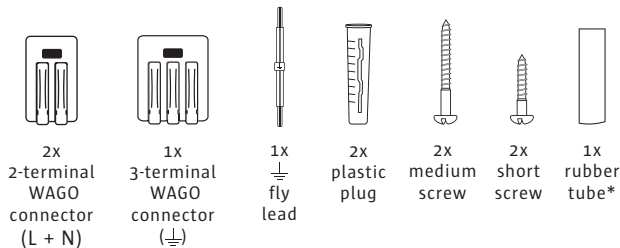

WARNING

- Nominal frequency 50 Hz
- This light fitting must be installed by a competent person, in accordance with current wiring and building regs. Find an NICEIC registered contractor at factorylux.com
- For indoor use only
- Shut off power to the circuit before installation
- Always use fixings appropriate for the mounting surface (screws supplied may not be suitable)
- Do not exceed wattage specified on product label (for Factorylux filament lamp exceptions - contact hello@factorylux.com)
- Bathroom installation by authorised contractor only
- Ensure grub screw is secure - WAGO terminals must be relieved from strain and twisting
- Maintain safe distance between light source and surfaces

USER INSTRUCTIONS

TOOLS REQUIRED

- Drill + 6mm masonry bit
- 6mm + 4mm flat head screwdrivers

INSTALLATION NOTES

- Pendant combinations vary. Instructions are for ceiling rose installation only

INSTALLATION (MASONRY SURFACE)

WARNING: Light fitting to be insulated and earthed in accordance with current wiring regs

1. Drill 2 x 6mm holes x 30mm deep at 50.8mm centre spacings
2. Insert plastic plugs into holes
3. Remove brass screws and separate surface cup from pattress
4. Use 6mm screwdriver and supplied medium screws to fix pattress to surface (alternatively, use supplied short screws only to fix pattress to a timber surface)
5. Re-locate rubber gasket between surface cup and pattress
6. Use supplied WAGO connectors to make L, N and \perp connections (as per 'wiring diagram')
 - Flip integrated orange lever up to open position
 - Insert exposed conductor to stopping point
 - Return lever to closed position
7. Re-attach surface cup to pattress using brass screws
8. Use chain to connect hooks

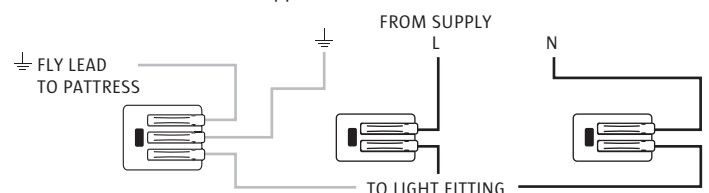
ADJUSTING

WARNING: WAGO terminals must be relieved from strain or twisting

- Release grub screw with 4mm flat head screwdriver
- Adjust fabric cable to required length **NOTE:** Do not remove batch code label
- Tighten grub screw to same tightness as before

WIRING DIAGRAM

WARNING: Ensure no loose copper strands



HANDLING & CLEANING

WARNING: Shut off power and allow to cool

- Wipe gently with a dry, soft, cotton cloth
- Cleaning products, scratching, abrasion, damp, oils, liquids etc may have a detrimental effect
