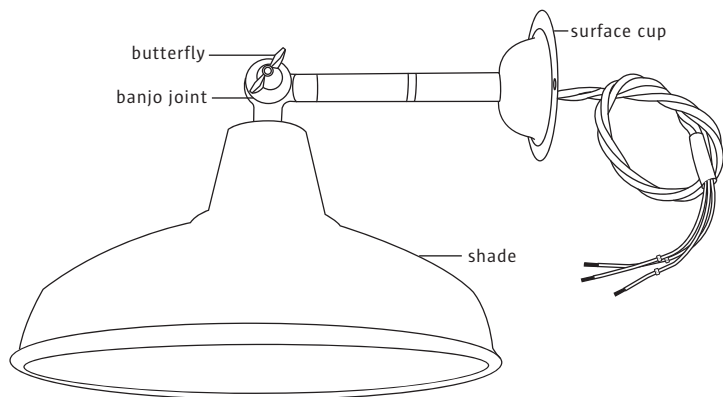


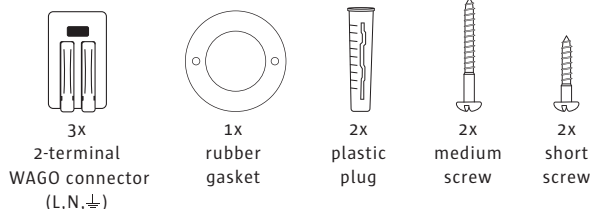

### WARNING

- For indoor use only
- Shut off power to the circuit before installation
- Always use fixings appropriate for the mounting surface (screws supplied may not be suitable)
- Do not exceed wattage specified on product label (for Factorylux filament lamp exceptions - contact [hello@factorylux.com](mailto:hello@factorylux.com))
- Bathroom installation by authorised contractor only
- Maintain safe distance from lamp holder to surfaces
- Ensure lamp does not contact surfaces

## USER INSTRUCTIONS

### TOOLS REQUIRED

- Drill + 6mm masonry bit
- 6mm flat head screwdriver

### INSTALLATION NOTES

- Surface cup is designed to be fixed to a solid horizontal or vertical surface, using appropriate fixings
- Surface cup is not designed to house an electrical connection
- We recommend using a pattress (surface mounted enclosure) to house the electrical connection. It is simpler, neater and safer
- Separate installation instructions are supplied with the pattress (available from [factorylux.com](http://factorylux.com))
- Alternatively, a suitable non-combustible enclosure in a ceiling void is required to make a connection

### INSTALLATION (MASONRY SURFACE)

**WARNING:** Light fitting to be insulated and earthed in accordance with current wiring regs

1. Drill 2 x 6mm holes x 30mm deep at 50.8mm centre spacings
2. Insert plastic plugs into holes
3. Locate rubber gasket between surface cup and surface
4. Use supplied WAGO connectors to make L, N and  $\perp$  connections
  - Flip integrated orange lever up to open position
  - Insert exposed conductor to stopping point
  - Return lever to closed position
5. Use screwdriver and supplied medium screws to fix light fitting to the surface (alternatively, use supplied short screws only to fix to a timber surface)

### ADJUSTING

**WARNING:** Shut off power and allow to cool

**CAUTION:** Failure to loosen butterfly when adjusting may cause irreversible damage

- Loosen butterfly (anti clockwise), reposition as required
- Tighten butterfly (clockwise), finger tight (do not over tighten)

### HANDLING & CLEANING

**WARNING:** Shut off power and allow to cool

- Wipe gently with a dry, soft, cotton cloth
- Cleaning products, scratching, abrasion, damp, oils, liquids etc may have a detrimental effect
